About the Scholarship

The All India Rail Safety Council (AIRSC) proudly announces the AASDM Scholarship for deserving and economically challenged students pursuing Safety Management and Engineering courses under the AIRSC Academy of Safety and Disaster Management.

This initiative reflects AIRSC's unwavering commitment to promoting Total Safety Education and nurturing the future safety leaders of India. Each year, AIRSC extends academic and financial assistance to talented students — both Indian and international — who are dedicated to excelling in the fields of Safety Management, Engineering, and Disaster Preparedness.

Objective

The objective of this scholarship scheme is to support meritorious students from economically weaker sections by providing them with access to quality higher education and helping them enhance their employability in the safety and engineering sectors.

Scope

This scholarship is applicable only to students enrolled in the AIRSC Academy of Safety and Disaster Management, under the All India Rail Safety Council. Eligibility Criteria

• Students who have passed Class XII (or equivalent) in the Academic Year 2023–24 or later with at least 60% marks and whose family income does not exceed ₹2,40,000/- per annum are eligible.



- 1. For diploma-level courses, the minimum educational qualification is Class X (or equivalent) with 60% marks.
- 2. The applicant must be enrolled or seeking admission in Safety Management / Safety Engineering / Disaster Management (UG, PG, or Diploma) programs offered by AIRSC Academy.
- 3. Preference will be given to students from rural or underprivileged backgrounds with strong academic records and a commitment to the field of safety.

Duration

The scholarship is valid for the entire duration of the course, subject to satisfactory academic performance and compliance with renewal conditions each year.

Rate of Scholarship

- Amount: ₹2,40,000 per annum
- Mode: Direct Bank Transfer (NEFT) in 10 monthly instalments of ₹2,000 each
- Renewal is based on continued academic progress and attendance.

Conditions and Norms

- Scholarship awarded only to students securing 60% or above in their previous qualifying exam.
- Family income must not exceed ₹2,40,000/- per annum (income proof mandatory).
- Students must maintain a minimum of 55% in professional courses or 50% in general degree courses to continue the scholarship.
- Only one student per family will be eligible.
- The student must maintain regular attendance as per institutional norms.
- Income certificate should be self-certified (affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper for self-employed parents or employer certificate for salaried parents).
- Misrepresentation or falsification of documents will lead to cancellation and recovery of scholarship funds.
- The scholarship may be suspended or withdrawn in case of misconduct, poor attendance, or violation of AIRSC rules.
- Selection will be based on merit-cum-means, with preference to candidates with the lowest family income.
- The decision of the AIRSC Governing Body shall be final and binding in all matters.
- AIRSC reserves the right to amend, withdraw, or modify any condition of this scheme at any time without prior notice.
- The scheme will be periodically reviewed and evaluated by AIRSC's Academic Committee to ensure fairness and transparency.

How to Apply

- Interested students can apply online through the AIRSC website.
- Upon successful submission, applicants will receive an acknowledgement email from the National Office of AIRSC.
- Applicants must ensure that their email ID, mobile number, and postal address are correct for future communication.
- Bank Account details and IFSC code may be submitted later upon final selection.
